Key Words:

God – The infinite divine being, one in being yet three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. God has revealed Himself as the “One who is,” as truth and love, as Creator of all that is, as the Author of Divine Revelation, and as the Source of Salvation.

Soul – The spiritual principle of human beings. The soul is the subject of human consciousness and freedom; soul and body together form one unique human nature. Each human soul is individual and immortal, immediately created by God. The soul does not die with the body, from which it is separated by death, and with which it will be reunited in the final resurrection.

Human Person – The human individual, made in the image of God; not some thing but someone, a unity of spirit and matter, soul and body, capable of knowledge, self-possession, and freedom, who can enter into communion with other persons and with God.
